

## IRIS SHOW SET FOR JUNE 5

Pocatello's annual iris show is scheduled for June 5 at the Red Lion Hotel. It is the show's 15<sup>th</sup> year, and is presented by the Pocatello Garden Club. The show is the core of the iris festival, which features garden tours the week of the show and a plant sale in July. This amateur gardeners' show has featured over 200 exhibits.
